Masterbatch Workshop with the „Grain of Difference“

Leistritz event convinced with substantiated lectures and interesting machine demonstrations

Nuremberg (Nov. 5th, 2009) – „The Grain of Difference“ – this was the slogan of the International Masterbatch Workshop, which was held on November 3rd and 4th by the renown German company Leistritz Extrusionstechnik GmbH. The event, which took place for the ninth time, offered a well-balanced mixture of theory and practice for over 150 participants from 24 countries. „We are very glad about the enormous feedback, especially, if one considers the difficult times the market had to face this year“, Dr. Hubertus Schulte, CEO at Leistritz. „But it got around that our workshops offer a unique knowledge transfer which is undermined by top-class expert lectures as well as on-the-spot presentations of the ZSE MAXX machines in our lab.“

Lectures and Live Shows

Amongst others, the following topics were in the focus: Mario Dittes from BASF attended to the quality criteria when producing effect pigment masterbatches. His colleague Dr. Christian Guckel explained what is important when dispersing organic pigments. Hermann Diem from Clariant Germany stated how Licocene® is used as dispersive agent and as independent carrier for highly filled pigment masterbatches. Prof. Dr. Gerd Wehnert from the Georg-Simon-Ohm University in Nuremberg and the head of the Leistritz lab Alexander Koschmieder presented an interesting residence time study. It was carried out by comparing the ZSE MAXX and ZSE HP series using various screw geometries. For all mentioned topics extensive studies and tests were previously run on different ZSE MAXX machines. The results were demonstrated live in the Leistritz lab.
